

Stark Bros Ltd is routinely required to manufacture a wide range of items in a variety of materials to complete its various contracts. Frequent input into the design phase results in an effective share of experience between owners and contractor.

Stark Bros provides in-house machining of large items with its specialist lathe facilities that accommodate swinging of items up to 1.4 metres in diameter x 10 metres in length over the bed.

Design and manufacture of other items by Stark Bros Ltd includes ISO container spreaders, certified lifting cages, winches and gangways. As a true full service marine specialist, Stark Bros Ltd operates a well equipped fleet of heavy trucks, equipment and storage buildings/yards for:

- Transport of equipment and materials in relation to ship repairs being undertaken
- Transport and storage of fishing equipment, fishing nets and packaging
- Receipt, storage and forwarding of ships stores
- Removal and transport of waste oil, bilge water processing facilities and tank cleaning
- Dry general rubbish disposal via rubbish skip collection

Vessels of all shapes and sizes

Every aspect of dry dock requirements can be managed from pre-contract information to the completion of required works and beyond.

Work undertaken in the dry dock includes — hull, deck or engine repairs, structural, plating and tank repairs, tailshaft and propeller survey and repairs, preparation and painting, echo sounder installations and any other underwater repair/modification required.

The Lyttelton dry dock is located adjacent to Stark Bros Ltd main workshop facilities.

Dry dock specifications —

- Floor length 137.15 metres
- Floor width 14 metres
- Top length 146.75 metres
- Entrance width 18.80 metres
- Maximum draft 6.1 metres (subject to vessel type)

Stark Bros Ltd has built boats since its beginnings in 1958. Most vessels have been of a commercial nature, designed and built in-house — from small clinker dinghys, to fast cray boats, barges, a steel tug, workboats, trawlers, in timber and steel.

While predominantly a ship repair/marine engineering company, the traditions of boat building continue.


Stark Bros Ltd undertakes design and building of commercial vessels to approximately 25 metres in length depending on type/configuration.


